MINUTE 103 – FINANCE

It was suggested that a Finance Committee should be set up to meet approximately every three months with Terms of Reference. Agenda October meeting to elect members.

- 1. Finance for cleaning of the Town Hall and toilets by a contractor will be funded from Brown Signs monies.
- 2. MCBPT is taking on a full repairing lease.
- 3. It was suggested to offer a lower dowry for five years while work mentioned in the Condition Survey is carried out and to precept six months running costs
- 4. Review break point each year and request six months notice for the first five years and review five yearly thereafter.
- 5. Town Council will pay for Town Clock and Hanging Baskets, plus 75% of the costs for public toilets for five years after which Council will review with the MCBPT.

- 6. A joint party will be organised to discuss prioritising items on Condition Survey.
- 7. An electrical survey will be carried out although this will not hold up decisions on the lease.
- 8. Agree where possible to produce certificates and maintenance records.
- 9. Grant to MCBPT of £5K starting in April 2020 for five years (if lease has been completed at this time) after which council will review the situation.
- 10. Write to MCBPT with this decision.
- 11. Letter of thanks to Mr Michaels.
